

Site Coordinator Instructions for "D" License Course

Duration

The "D" License Course is a 36-hour course, however 42 hours of time is scheduled to allow for recovery and breaks. Attendance is mandatory to pass course.

Examination

There is an oral examination on tactics and methods. There is also a graded take home exam on laws, team management, and care and prevention. Candidates must pass written and practical examinations.

Facilities

A classroom and field are needed. An indoor field will be needed in case of inclement weather. If there is a facility fee for the course, you are able to add a facility fee on to the price. We must have the invoice prior to the course directly from the facility. We will not reimburse clubs for facility fees.

Applicants

The minimum number of candidates is 20. The maximum number of candidates is determined by the size of the facility. ***The hosting organization agrees if the minimum number of candidates are not met and wish to continue to host the course, agree to provide the difference in costs between the number of attendee's and the minimum number of attendees required.*** The number of candidates is set one week before the course begins according to the number of instructors required. One Coaching Education Program (CEP) staff instructor/evaluator per eight candidates is required for all coaching practice and evaluation sessions.

Registration and Fees

Fees for candidates taking the "D" License course are:

- \$150 per participant (\$125 for OSYSA Coaches)

Coaches wishing to attend the course will have to register and make payment online. They do not register with you directly. They may choose to pay the full amount or the deposit online. You will receive a list of the coaches scheduled to attend the course a couple days prior to the course. That list will include any balance due that needs to be collected by you from the participants. Please note that it is the site coordinator's responsibility, not the instructor's, to check in and/or collect payments from the participants. The checks are to be made payable to OSYSA.

Post-Course Action

After the course is completed, you will need to mail in the coaches registration list along with any checks or onsite registration forms collected to the Ohio South office within 7 days of the completion of the course. The instructor will be responsible for sending the evaluations and test results to the Ohio South office within 14 days.

General

Applicants should bring a soccer ball; training suit, sweat suit, or any form of action clothing; gym shoes; soccer cleats; and writing materials.

It is important that you establish a communications scheme in the event of inclement weather.

The OSYSA State Office will email course certificates directly to the student coaches successfully completing the course. Prompt submission of the completed, onsite registration forms and payment of any amounts due is, therefore, imperative.

The course being offered is open to all OSYSA membership; the hosting organization does not have exclusivity in relation to attendance.

In order to advertise the course in an effective manner, OSYSA requires that the course be contracted 30 days before the start date of the course.
