

'E' License Prerequisite Coursework - Summary

All pre-coursework should be completed by the BEGINNING of your scheduled 'E' license if possible. If any portion of the pre-coursework has not been completed, the 'E' license cannot be awarded until all components of the course have been satisfied.

Should I plan on completing all pre-coursework before I begin my scheduled 'E' license?

Yes, the course is set on the premise that all candidates have completed all assigned pre-coursework and the relevant completion certificates.

What happens if I cannot complete all the pre-coursework?

You can still take the 'E' license, however the license cannot be awarded until pre-coursework is completed and relevant documentation collected and approved by the Ohio South State office.
